Project Overview:

- . 37-unit apartment building: 29 one-bedroom, 1 two-bedroom, and 7 studios
- · All units will have preference to artists and local residents
- · All units restricted to tenants with incomes below 60% Area Median Income

Points of Interest:

- Building will provide live-in workspaces for artists and creatives
- The building exterior and interior design will incorporate the creations of resident artists and retain existing historical assets originating in the structure and community

Goals and Benefits:

- An affordable housing opportunity within an economically distressed community located in the post-industrial area of the Mon Valley
- · The addition of housing units designed for the physically and hearing impaired
- Improves the existing main pedestrian thoroughfare by rehabilitating a former prominent structure located in the main business district
- Market-rate design that transforms a currently underutilized property into multiple affordable apartments
